AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to prohibiting denial of entry to a public place or denial of service solely on the basis of wearing a mask in public during an epidemic or a pandemic

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 296 of the executive law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (i) to read as follows:
- 3 (i) For any person, agency, bureau, corporation or association,
- 4 <u>including the state and any political subdivision thereof, to deny a</u> 5 <u>person entry to a public place or deny a person service solely on the</u>
- 6 basis of wearing a mask in public during a state emergency for an
- 7 epidemic or a pandemic.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
