AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to increasing the sales and compensating use taxes for the county of Steuben

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1262-h of the tax law, as amended by section 2 of item SS of subpart C of part XXX of chapter 58 of the laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:

§ 1262-h. Allocation and distribution of net collections from the additional one percent rate of sales and compensating use taxes in Steuben county. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, of the 7 net collections received by the county of Steuben as a result of the imposition of the additional one percent rate of tax authorized by 9 section twelve hundred ten of this article (a) during the period begin-10 ning December first, nineteen hundred ninety-three and ending November thirtieth, nineteen hundred ninety-four, the county of Steuben shall pay 11 12 or cause to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum of two hundred thou-13 sand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of three hundred thousand dollars, and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars to the towns and 15 villages of the county of Steuben, on the basis of the ratio which the 16 full valuation of real property in each town or village bears to the 17 aggregate full valuation of real property in all of the towns and 18 villages in such area. Of the net collections received by the county of Steuben as a result of the imposition of said additional one percent 19 rate of tax authorized by section twelve hundred ten of this article 21 during the period beginning December first, nineteen hundred ninety-four and ending November thirtieth, nineteen hundred ninety-five, the county 23 of Steuben shall pay or cause to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum 24 of three hundred thousand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of four hundred fifty thousand dollars, and the sum of seven hundred fifty 26 thousand dollars to the towns and villages of the county of Steuben, on the basis of the ratio which the full valuation of real property in each 27

town or village bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property in all of the towns and villages in such area; and (b) during the period 3 beginning December first, nineteen hundred ninety-five and ending November thirtieth, two thousand seven, the county of Steuben shall annually pay or cause to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum of five hundred fifty thousand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of six hundred thousand dollars, and the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars to 7 the towns and villages of the county of Steuben, on the basis of the 9 ratio which the full valuation of real property in each town or village 10 bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property in all of 11 towns and villages in such area; and during the period beginning December first, two thousand seven and ending November thirtieth, two thou-12 13 sand nine, the county of Steuben shall annually pay or cause to be paid 14 to the city of Hornell the sum of six hundred ten thousand dollars, the city of Corning the sum of six hundred fifty thousand dollars, and 15 the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars to the towns and 16 villages of the county of Steuben, on the basis of the ratio which the 17 18 full valuation of real property in each town or village bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property in all of the towns and 19 20 villages in such area; and during the period beginning December first, 21 two thousand nine and ending November thirtieth, two thousand eleven, the county of Steuben shall annually pay or cause to be paid to the city 22 of Hornell the sum of seven hundred ten thousand dollars, to the city of 23 Corning the sum of seven hundred ten thousand dollars, and the sum of 24 25 seven hundred fifty thousand dollars to the towns and villages of the 26 county of Steuben, on the basis of the ratio which the full valuation of 27 real property in each town or village bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property in all of the towns and villages in such area; 28 29 and during the period beginning December first, two thousand eleven and 30 ending November thirtieth, two thousand thirteen, the county of Steuben 31 shall annually pay or cause to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum of 32 seven hundred forty thousand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of 33 seven hundred forty thousand dollars, and the sum of seven hundred fifty 34 thousand dollars to the towns and villages of the county of Steuben, on 35 the basis of the ratio which the full valuation of real property in each 36 town or village bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property 37 the towns and villages in such area; and during the period all of 38 beginning December first, two thousand thirteen and ending November thirtieth, two thousand fifteen, the county of Steuben shall annually 39 pay or cause to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum of seven hundred 40 41 sixty-five thousand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of seven 42 hundred sixty-five thousand dollars, and the sum of seven hundred fifty 43 thousand dollars to the towns and villages of the county of Steuben, on 44 the basis of the ratio which the full valuation of real property in each 45 town or village bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property 46 in all of the towns and villages in such area; and during the period 47 beginning December first, two thousand fifteen and ending November thirtieth, two thousand seventeen, the county of Steuben shall annually pay 48 49 or cause to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum of seven hundred 50 sixty-five thousand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of seven 51 hundred sixty-five thousand dollars, and the sum of seven hundred fifty 52 thousand dollars to the towns and villages of the county of Steuben, the basis of the ratio which the full valuation of real property in each 53 54 town or village bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property in all of the towns and villages in such area; and during the period 55 beginning December first, two thousand seventeen and ending November

1 thirtieth, two thousand twenty, the county of Steuben shall annually pay or cause to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum of seven hundred eighty thousand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of seven hundred 3 eighty thousand dollars, and the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars to the towns and villages of the county of Steuben, on the basis of the ratio which the full valuation of real property in each town or village bears to the aggregate full valuation of real property in all of the towns and villages in such area; and during the period beginning 9 December first, two thousand twenty and ending November thirtieth, two 10 thousand twenty-three, the county of Steuben shall annually pay or cause 11 to be paid to the city of Hornell the sum of [seven] eight hundred [eighty] twenty thousand dollars, to the city of Corning the sum of 12 13 [seven] eight hundred [eighty] twenty thousand dollars, and the sum of 14 seven hundred [fifty] ninety thousand dollars to the towns and villages of the county of Steuben, on the basis of the ratio which the full valu-15 ation of real property in each town or village bears to the aggregate 17 full valuation of real property in all of the towns and villages in such 18
