- AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to suspending the excise tax on certain drugs during a declared state of emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 498 of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision (h) to read as follows:

3 (h) During a state of emergency as declared by the governor for the

4 <u>novel coronavirus, COVID-19, no tax shall be collected on fentanyl,</u>
5 <u>hydromorphone, codeine and any other finished-dose prescription drugs</u>

6 <u>identified</u> by the commissioner of health as necessary for the public 7 <u>health.</u>

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all 9 returns filed for quarterly periods beginning on and after April 1, 10 2020.
