AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the sale of children's jewelry containing lead

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision 5 of section 37-0115 2 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 43 of the 3 laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:

4 Effective [January] July first, two thousand twenty-one, no manufac-5 turer shall sell, or offer for sale, children's jewelry that contains a 6 total lead content in any component part of the item that is more than 7 0.004% (40 parts per million) but less than 0.01% (100 parts per 8 million) by total weight or a lower standard for lead content as may be 9 established by federal or state law or rule unless that item bears a 10 warning statement that indicates that at least one component part of the 11 item contains lead.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
