AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Sergeant Gregory Wahl Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-1 to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-1. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Sergeant Gregory Wahl Memorial Highway". All that portion of the state 5 highway system constituting the southern state parkway between Sagtikos 6 Parkway and Route 111 in the town of Islip, county of Suffolk, shall be designated and known as the "Sergeant Gregory Wahl Memorial Highway".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 10 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
