AN ACT in relation to establishing a Caumsett State Park fire readiness study

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The office of fire prevention and control and the department of parks, recreation and historic preservation shall conduct a study to evaluate the adequacy and coverage of fire services within the Caumsett State Park, including, but not limited to, accessing the state park during emergencies.

- § 2. The office of fire prevention and control shall submit its findings to the governor, temporary president of the senate and speaker of the assembly within one year of the effective date of this act.
- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
