AN ACT in relation to ordering a study and report on improvements of State Route 9A in the towns of Ossining and Mount Pleasant; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The department of transportation is hereby authorized and  
2 directed to conduct a study on proposed improvements of State Route 9A  
3 in the towns of Ossining and Mount Pleasant.
- 4 1. Such study shall address no less than the following issues:  
5 (a) The estimated total cost of new guardrail installation;  
6 (b) The estimated total cost of underpass renovations to accommodate  
7 commercial vehicles;  
8 (c) The estimated duration of the project;  
9 (d) The impact construction will have on local traffic patterns;  
10 (e) The environmental impact of the project, represented in an envi-  
11 ronmental impact statement, if such statement is required by law, or is  
12 deemed warranted according to the discretion of the department of trans-  
13 portation; and  
14 (f) Identify areas for cooperation between agencies who have purview  
15 over this project and/or relevant properties and solicit and incorporate  
16 input from such agencies.
- 17 2. The department of transportation shall report such findings to the  
18 governor and the legislature within one year after the effective date of  
19 this act.
- 20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire one year  
21 after it shall have become a law when upon such date the provisions of  
22 this act shall be deemed repealed.
