AN ACT directing the commissioner of health to study the effectiveness and accuracy of devices used to estimate blood alcohol content by law enforcement agencies

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of health is authorized and directed to study the effectiveness and accuracy of devices used to estimate blood alcohol content by law enforcement agencies. Such study shall include, but not be limited to:

- (a) which devices are used by law enforcement agencies;
- (b) the accuracy of devices used by law enforcement agencies;
- 7 (c) the margin of error for devices which are used by law enforcement 8 agencies;
  - (d) the likelihood of an inaccurate reading; and
- 10 (e) any other related information that the commissioner may deem 11 necessary or relevant in carrying out this study.
- § 2. The commissioner of health shall make a report to the governor and the legislature of his or her findings, conclusions and recommendations no later than one year after the effective date of this act and shall submit with this report such legislative proposals as it deems
- 16 necessary to implement its recommendations.
