AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to a deduction for small business employers for certain wages and compensation paid to employees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 612 of the tax law is amended by 2 adding a new paragraph 44 to read as follows:
- 3 (44) In the case of a taxpayer who is a small business as defined
 4 pursuant to section one hundred thirty-one of the economic development
 5 law, an amount equal to twenty-five percent of the wages, salary or
 6 compensation paid to up to ten employees who earn up to one hundred ten
 7 percent of the minimum wage as established in the labor law or any mini8 mum wage established by a wage board pursuant to section six hundred
 9 fifty-five of the labor law for that taxable year.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to taxable 11 years beginning on and after January 1, 2021.
