AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring all homeless shelters overseen by the division of shelter oversight and compliance at the office of temporary and disability assistance to provide internet access to all residents

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 44 of the social services law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5-a to read as follows:

5-a. The commissioner shall require that all homeless shelters overseen by the division of shelter oversight and compliance at the office of temporary and disability services provide internet access to all residents.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately. Effective immediately, 8 the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation neces-9 sary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are 10 authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
