AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to establishing a transgender and non-binary peer support grant program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 2 7.49 to read as follows:
- 8 § 7.49 Transgender and non-binary peer support grant program.
 - (a) As used in this section:
- 5 (1) "Program" shall mean the "transgender and non-binary peer support grant program" established by this section.
- 7 (2) "Eligible entities" shall mean entities which submit to the commissioner an application, in a form prescribed by the commissioner,
- 9 <u>containing such information and assurances as the commissioner may</u>
 10 <u>require to provide initial and continued training in mental illness,</u>
- including but not limited to post-traumatic stress disorder and suicide
- 12 prevention.
- 13 <u>(b) The commissioner shall, subject to appropriation, establish a</u>
 14 <u>grant program to be known as the "transgender and non-binary peer</u>
 15 <u>support grant program".</u>
- 16 (c) The program shall award grants, with appropriations therefor, to
 17 eligible entities for the purpose of establishing peer-to-peer mental
 18 health programs for transgender and non-binary individuals.
- 19 <u>(d) The commissioner shall develop and establish standards applicable</u> 20 <u>to the program. Such standards shall include, but not be limited to,</u>
- 21 <u>initial and continued training for transgender and non-binary volun-</u>
- 22 teers, administrative staffing needs, and best practices for addressing
- 23 the needs of the community to be served.
- 24 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
