AN ACT to rename the Oakwood Beach wetland the Oakwood Beach-Detective Russel Timoshenko Preserve

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The area managed by the department of environmental conservation known as Oakwood Beach wetland, located in Richmond county, shall after the effective date of this act be known as the Oakwood Beach-Detective Russel Timoshenko Preserve and shall be suitably marked in a manner prescribed by the commissioner of environmental conservation.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
