AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring all commercial buildings be retrofitted with motion detectors for controlling lighting

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 378 of the executive law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 20 to read as follows:

3

20. Standards requiring that all commercial buildings exclusively use 4 motion detectors for controlling lighting. All commercial buildings 5 shall complete any retrofitting required to meet such standards on or 6 before the effective date of this subdivision.

§ 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its 10 effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such 11 effective date.
