AN ACT to authorize Donald Quehl to take the competitive civil service examination and be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a full-time police officer for the village of Pulaski, county of Oswego

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 58 of the civil service law, or any other law to the contrary, Donald Quehl, who has been continuously employed by the village of Pulaski, in the county of Oswego, as a part-time police officer, shall be eligible to take the competitive civil service examination for the position of police officer and shall, contingent upon his score on such examination, be eligible to be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a full-time police officer for the village of Pulaski.

- 9 § 2. Donald Quehl shall otherwise be subject to the merit and fitness 10 provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time police offi-11 cers.
- 12 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
