AN ACT to amend the public buildings law, in relation to requiring gender neutral bathrooms in state-owned buildings

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The section heading of section 145 of the public buildings law, as amended by chapter 14 of the laws of 2020, is amended, subdivision 1 is amended by adding a new paragraph (e), and two new subdivisions 1-a and 3 are added to read as follows:

Gender neutral [single-occupancy] bathrooms.

- 6 (e) "multiple-occupancy bathroom" means a room or suite of rooms
 7 containing at least one sink and at least two sanitary fixtures, such as
 8 toilets or urinals, intended for simultaneous use by two or more occu9 pants.
- 10 <u>1-a. All state-owned buildings and, where practicable, state-leased</u>
 11 <u>buildings shall include gender neutral bathrooms.</u>
- 3. When a state agency is unable to comply with subdivision two of
 this section, such state agency shall ensure that there is at least one
 gender neutral multiple-occupancy bathroom in the state-owned buildings
 under its jurisdiction and, where practicable, in the state-leased
 buildings under its jurisdiction.
- 17 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
