AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to creating the crime of unlawful possession of a radio frequency jamming device

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 270.45 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 270.45 Unlawful possession of a radio frequency jamming device.
- A person is guilty of unlawful possession of a radio frequency jamming

  device when, having no right to do so, they knowingly possess a device

  capable of disrupting and/or interfering with wireless communications

  through radio noise or signals.
- 8 <u>Unlawful possession of a radio frequency jamming device is a class D</u>
  9 <u>felony.</u>
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 11 have become a law.
