AN ACT in relation to requiring school districts to provide educational and support services to students with disabilities until such students turn twenty-three years of age

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, rule or regulation to  
2 the contrary, in recognition of the difficulties distance learning  
3 during the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic poses to students with disa-  
4 bilities, and the educational opportunities for students with disabili-  
5 ties that were lost or hampered, each New York school district shall  
6 provide educational and support services to students with disabilities  
7 in special education programs and to pupils who are qualified hand-  
8 icapped persons as defined in the federal rehabilitation act of nineteen  
9 hundred seventy-three, as amended, in accordance with the student's most  
10 recent Individualized Education Program (IEP) until such student turns  
11 twenty-three years of age for the school years 2019-2020, 2020-2021 and  
12 2021-2022.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to the  
14 2019-2020, 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school years only.
