AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the unlawful sale of law enforcement identification

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 139 to read as follows: 3 § 139. Unlawful sale of law enforcement insignia. No person shall sell 4 any badge, shield, identification card or other insignia of any police 5 department or law enforcement agency of any county, city, town, village, 6 commission or authority of this state, or a facsimile of any such badge, 7 shield, identification card or insignia except as authorized by rule or 8 regulation adopted by such police department or law enforcement agency. 9 A violation of the provisions of this section shall be punishable by a 10 civil penalty of not more than two hundred fifty dollars for each 11 violation. 12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
