AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the sale, use and application of styrene and products containing styrene by appearance enhancement businesses

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 404-d to read as follows:
- § 404-d. Styrene. 1. No owner or operator of an appearance enhancement business shall knowingly:
- 5 <u>a. sell, use or apply to any person styrene or a product containing</u> 6 <u>styrene; or</u>
- 5 b. direct any agent or employee of such business to sell, use or apply to any person styrene or a product containing styrene.
- 9 2. A first violation of this section shall be punishable by a civil
 10 penalty of not more than one thousand dollars. A second or any subsequent violation of this section shall be a class B misdemeanor.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
