AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring the incorporation of the structured multisensory approach into all required literacy courses for prospective teachers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 57 to read as follows:

57. The commissioner shall establish and enforce rules and regulations
requiring every institution of higher education that offers a graduate
or undergraduate degree or certification program in education or educational administration located within the state to incorporate evidencebased, effective methods of teaching reading, which shall include
instruction in direct and explicit structured multisensory approaches,
also known as structured literacy, within the current required literacy
curriculum.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
