- AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law and the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to requiring the commissioner of addiction services and supports to establish a problem gambling education program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 19.09 of the mental hygiene law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision (m) to read as follows: (m) The commissioner, in consultation with the New York state gaming 3 4 commission shall establish a problem gambling education program to be completed by all individuals that have placed themselves on a self 5 6 exclusion list pursuant to section one hundred eleven of the racing, 7 pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law upon the expiration of the selected exclusion period. This education program shall be made avail-8 able on the websites of both the office and the New York state gaming 9 commission and shall include but not be limited to resources to treat-10 11 ment. § 2. The opening paragraph of paragraph (a) and paragraph (c) of 12 13 subdivision 2 of section 111 of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and 14 breeding law, as amended by chapter 564 of the laws of 2021, are amended to read as follows: 15 16 The commission shall promulgate rules and regulations pursuant to
