AN ACT to amend the New York state urban development corporation act, in relation to renaming the empire state trail the Governor Malcolm Wilson empire state trail

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The trail currently known as the empire state trail shall 2 be designated and known as the Governor Malcolm Wilson empire state 3 trail and shall be referred to as such in all state publications, promo-4 tional materials, and websites.

5 § 2. Section 44 of section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, 6 constituting the New York state urban development corporation act, as 7 amended by section 41 of part JJ of chapter 56 of the laws of 2020, is 8 amended to read as follows:

§ 44. Issuance of certain bonds or notes. 1. Notwithstanding the 9 10 provisions of any other law to the contrary, the dormitory authority and 11 the corporation are hereby authorized to issue bonds or notes in one or 12 more series for the purpose of funding project costs for the regional 13 economic development council initiative, the economic transformation 14 program, state university of New York college for nanoscale and science 15 engineering, projects within the city of Buffalo or surrounding environs, the New York works economic development fund, projects for the 16 retention of professional football in western New York, the empire state 17 18 economic development fund, the clarkson-trudeau partnership, the New 19 York genome center, the cornell university college of veterinary medi-20 cine, the olympic regional development authority, projects at nano 21 Utica, onondaga county revitalization projects, Binghamton university 22 school of pharmacy, New York power electronics manufacturing consortium, 23 regional infrastructure projects, high tech innovation and economic

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development infrastructure program, high technology manufacturing 1 projects in Chautauqua and Erie county, an industrial scale research and 2 3 development facility in Clinton county, upstate revitalization initi-4 ative projects, downstate revitalization initiative, market New York 5 projects, fairground buildings, equipment or facilities used to house б and promote agriculture, the state fair, the Governor Malcolm Wilson 7 empire state trail, the moynihan station development project, the Kingsbridge armory project, strategic economic development projects, the 8 9 cultural, arts and public spaces fund, water infrastructure in the city 10 of Auburn and town of Owasco, a life sciences laboratory public health 11 initiative, not-for-profit pounds, shelters and humane societies, arts and cultural facilities improvement program, restore New York's communi-12 13 ties initiative, heavy equipment, economic development and infrastruc-14 ture projects, Roosevelt Island operating corporation capital projects, 15 Lake Ontario regional projects, Pennsylvania station and other transit 16 projects and other state costs associated with such projects. The aggre-17 gate principal amount of bonds authorized to be issued pursuant to this 18 section shall not exceed ten billion three hundred thirty-four million eight hundred fifty-one thousand dollars \$10,334,851,000, excluding 19 20 bonds issued to fund one or more debt service reserve funds, to pay 21 costs of issuance of such bonds, and bonds or notes issued to refund or otherwise repay such bonds or notes previously issued. Such bonds and 22 notes of the dormitory authority and the corporation shall not be a debt 23 the state, and the state shall not be liable thereon, nor shall they 24 of 25 be payable out of any funds other than those appropriated by the state 26 to the dormitory authority and the corporation for principal, interest, 27 and related expenses pursuant to a service contract and such bonds and notes shall contain on the face thereof a statement to such effect. 28 Except for purposes of complying with the internal revenue code, any 29 30 interest income earned on bond proceeds shall only be used to pay debt 31 service on such bonds.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, in 33 order to assist the dormitory authority and the corporation in undertak-34 ing the financing for project costs for the regional economic develop-35 ment council initiative, the economic transformation program, state 36 university of New York college for nanoscale and science engineering, 37 projects within the city of Buffalo or surrounding environs, the New 38 York works economic development fund, projects for the retention of 39 professional football in western New York, the empire state economic development fund, the clarkson-trudeau partnership, the New York genome 40 center, the cornell university college of veterinary medicine, the olym-41 42 pic regional development authority, projects at nano Utica, onondaga 43 county revitalization projects, Binghamton university school of pharma-44 cy, New York power electronics manufacturing consortium, regional 45 infrastructure projects, New York State Capital Assistance Program for 46 Transportation, infrastructure, and economic development, high tech 47 innovation and economic development infrastructure program, high technology manufacturing projects in Chautauqua and Erie county, an indus-48 49 trial scale research and development facility in Clinton county, upstate 50 revitalization initiative projects, downstate revitalization initiative, 51 market New York projects, fairground buildings, equipment or facilities 52 used to house and promote agriculture, the state fair, the Governor 53 Malcolm Wilson empire state trail, the moynihan station development 54 project, the Kingsbridge armory project, strategic economic development 55 projects, the cultural, arts and public spaces fund, water infrastruc-56 ture in the city of Auburn and town of Owasco, a life sciences laborato-

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1 ry public health initiative, not-for-profit pounds, shelters and humane societies, arts and cultural facilities improvement program, restore New 2 York's communities initiative, heavy equipment, economic development and 3 4 infrastructure projects, Roosevelt Island operating corporation capital 5 projects, Lake Ontario regional projects, Pennsylvania station and other б transit projects and other state costs associated with such projects the 7 director of the budget is hereby authorized to enter into one or more 8 service contracts with the dormitory authority and the corporation, none 9 of which shall exceed thirty years in duration, upon such terms and 10 conditions as the director of the budget and the dormitory authority and 11 the corporation agree, so as to annually provide to the dormitory authority and the corporation, in the aggregate, a sum not to exceed the 12 13 principal, interest, and related expenses required for such bonds and 14 notes. Any service contract entered into pursuant to this section shall 15 provide that the obligation of the state to pay the amount therein 16 provided shall not constitute a debt of the state within the meaning of 17 any constitutional or statutory provision and shall be deemed executory only to the extent of monies available and that no liability shall be 18 incurred by the state beyond the monies available for such purpose, 19 20 subject to annual appropriation by the legislature. Any such contract or 21 any payments made or to be made thereunder may be assigned and pledged 22 by the dormitory authority and the corporation as security for its bonds 23 and notes, as authorized by this section. 24 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
