Introduced by M. of A. LAVINE, SAYEGH -- read once and referred to the Committee on Transportation -- recommitted to the Committee on Transportation in accordance with Assembly Rule 3, sec. 2 -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to allowing valid certificates of marriage from foreign governments and religious institutions as acceptable documentation to change a name on the driver's license or non-driver identification card

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

1-a. In addition to any other documentation acceptable to the commissioner for the purposes of changing a person's name on a driver's license pursuant to subdivision one of this section, the commissioner may accept a valid certificate of marriage from the government of a foreign country or from a bona fide religious institution that issues certificates of marriage in a foreign country.

§ 2. Section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3-a. In addition to any other documentation acceptable to the commissioner for the purposes of changing a person's name on a learner's permit pursuant to subdivisions two and three of this section, the commissioner may accept a valid certificate of marriage from the government of a foreign country or from a bona fide religious institution that issues certificates of marriage in a foreign country.

§ 3. Section 490 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

2-a. In addition to any other documentation acceptable to the commissioner for purposes of changing a person's name on an identification

4 § 4. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall  
5 have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or  
6 repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of
