AN ACT to amend the private housing finance law, in relation to establishing the sustainable affordable housing incentive program

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. The private housing finance law is amended by adding a new
2	article 32 to read as follows:

8	§ 1290. Statement of legislative findings and purpose. The legislature
9	finds and declares that climate change is having a significant impact
10	upon our environment, health, and safety and it is necessary to imple-
11	ment programs and policies that immediately reduce greenhouse gas emis-
12	sions. The legislature further finds that residential housing is a
13	source for such emissions and we can only address climate change in a
14	meaningful manner if we change our practices and behaviors as they
15	relate to the construction of and improvements to such housing, such as
16	the use of environmentally-sensitive design and the construction prac-
17	tices and materials; the installation of energy efficient products; and
18	access to renewable energy sources. Establishing a new program to
19	encourage and publicly subsidize more environmentally-friendly practices
20	and materials will reduce greenhouse gas emissions from multi-unit hous-

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1	ing throughout New York state and help address climate change for future
2	generations.
3	§ 1291. Definitions. For the purposes of this article, the following
4	terms shall have the following meanings:
5	1. "Corporation" shall mean the housing trust fund corporation estab-
б	lished in section forty-five-a of this chapter.
7	2. "Sustainable affordable housing activities" shall mean activities
8	by an eligible applicant for a specific work or series of works for the
9	creation, preservation or improvement of affordable housing which will
10	reduce greenhouse gas emissions through the use of design, construction,
11	materials and products, and access to renewable energy sources that
12	exceed a greenhouse gas emissions baseline for such housing, as deter-
13	mined by the corporation in consultation with the New York state energy
14	research and development corporation.
15	3. "Eligible applicant" shall mean a not-for-profit corporation or
16	charitable organization, or a wholly-owned subsidiary of such a corpo-
17	ration or organization, or a private for-profit developer such as a
18	person, corporation, partnership or limited liability company.
19	4. "Affordable residential development" shall mean a multiple family
20	dwelling which is subject to a regulatory agreement with a local, state,
21	or federal government entity.
22	<u>§ 1292. Sustainable affordable housing incentive program. 1. Within</u>
23	amounts appropriated or otherwise available therefor, the corporation
24	shall develop and administer a sustainable affordable housing incentive
25	program which shall provide assistance in the form of payments, grants
26	and loans for reasonable and necessary expenses to an eligible applicant
27	for sustainable housing activities.
28	2. The corporation shall develop procedures, criteria and requirements
29	related to the application and award of projects pursuant to this
30	section which shall include: eligibility, market demand, feasibility
31	and funding criteria; the funding determination process; supervision and
32	evaluation of contracting applicants; reporting, budgeting and record-
33	keeping requirements; provisions for modification and termination of
34	contracts; and such other matters not inconsistent with the purposes and
35	provisions of this article as the corporation shall deem necessary or
36	appropriate.

37 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
