AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the use of pesticides containing Neonicotinoids

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 33-1301 of the environmental conservation law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
- 3 12. For any person to use any pesticide containing Neonicotinoids
- 4 ("neonics"), including but not limited to acetamiprid, clothianidin,
 5 imidacloprid, nitenpyram, nithiazine, thiacloprid, and thiamethoxam.
- 6 § 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2022.
