AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to prohibiting agencies from charging a fee for records where an electronic copy is already available from a previous request made within the past six months

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph iii of paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of 2 section 87 of the public officers law, as amended by chapter 223 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

iii. the fees for copies of records which shall not exceed twenty-five cents per photocopy not in excess of nine inches by fourteen inches, or the actual cost of reproducing any other record in accordance with the 7 provisions of paragraph (c) of this subdivision, except when a different 8 fee is otherwise prescribed by statute. In the case where an identical 9 record has been prepared for a previous request within the past 6 months 10 and an electronic copy is available, an agency shall not charge a fee. 11 If more than one request is made for an identical record before any such 12 request has been fulfilled, any fees charged by the agency under this 13 <u>subparagraph shall be apportioned equally among the requestors.</u>

14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
