AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to prohibiting smoking in certain outdoor areas

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section
2	1399-o-2 to read as follows:
3	<u>§ 1399-o-2. Smoking restrictions; certain outdoor areas. 1. Smoking</u>
4	shall not be permitted and no person shall smoke in any public park.
5	2. For the purposes of this section "park" shall mean:
б	(a) public parks, beaches, pools, boardwalks, marinas, playgrounds,
7	recreation centers, and group camps; and
8	(b) equipment, buildings and facilities now or hereafter under the
9	jurisdiction, charge or control of any state or local government agency
10	or department that are located at or on any property described in para-
11	graph (a) of this subdivision; provided, however, that for the purposes
12	of this section the term public park shall not include the Adirondack
13	park or the Catskill park as those terms are defined in section 9-0101
14	of the environmental conservation law.
15	3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to: (a) the side-
16	walks immediately adjoining parks, squares and public places; (b) any
17	pedestrian route through any park strip, median or mall that is adjacent
18	to vehicular traffic; (c) parking lots or roadways; (d) theatrical
19	productions; and (e) any portion of a park that is not used for park
20	purposes, except when smoking has been specifically prohibited in a
21	state park or portion thereof by the office of parks, recreation and
22	historic preservation. This subdivision shall not limit the applicabil-
23	ity of any other laws to such places.

1 § 2. Section 1399-v of the public health law, as added by chapter 244
2 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as follows:

§ 1399-v. Penalties. The commissioner may impose a civil penalty for 3 4 a violation of this article in an amount not to exceed that set forth in 5 subdivision one of section twelve of this chapter. Any other enforcement 6 officer may impose a civil penalty for a violation of this article in an amount not to exceed that set forth in paragraph $[\frac{1}{2}]$ of subdivision 7 8 one of section three hundred nine of this chapter. Notwithstanding the 9 foregoing provisions, a violation of the provisions of section thirteen 10 hundred ninety-nine-o-two of this article shall be punishable by a civil 11 penalty of fifty dollars for each violation. § 3.
