AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to prohibiting virginity examinations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 267-a to read as follows:

§ 267-a. Prohibition of virginity examinations. No person shall perform a physical examination used or intended to determine whether a female has previously had sexual intercourse.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law.
