The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The legislative law is amended by adding a new section 2-a 2 to read as follows:
- § 2-a. Legislative term limits. Members of the legislature shall not serve more than four two-year terms in either the senate or the assembly.
- 6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all 7 elections held after this act shall have become a law.
