AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to preventing time limits being placed on standardized tests given in cities with a population of one million or more

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 7 <u>istered by the city district shall be subject to any time limitation</u> 8 <u>when such assessment, test or examination is administered to a student</u>
- 9 who attends the city district.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
