AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the certification of dietitians and nutritionists

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 8001 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a 4 certified dietitian or certified nutritionist may prescribe, order, 5 write, review, evaluate, monitor and manage therapeutic diets, including 6 enteral and parenteral nutrition, in a hospital, including diagnostic center, treatment center, or hospital-based outpatient department, residential health care facility or nursing home or any other facility as defined in section twenty-eight hundred one of the public health law 10 when competency is determined by the medical director or governing body 11 of such facility.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 13 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition and/or 14 repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of 15 this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed 16 on or before such effective date.
