AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to requiring employers to provide paid sick leave to employees following a miscarriage or still-birth

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 196-b of the labor law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 1-a to read as follows:
- 1-a. In addition to any other requirements of this section, every
 4 employer shall be required to provide each employee with the equivalent
 5 number of hours as three full work days for such employee of paid sick
- 6 leave for a miscarriage or stillbirth of an infant born to the employee.
- 7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
