AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to prohibiting the requirement that a court proceeding has been initiated against an individual in order for such individual to qualify for a rent arrears grant or ongoing rental assistance

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 131 of the social services law, is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 21 to read as follows:
- 21. Notwithstanding any other section of law to the contrary, proof of a court proceeding that has been initiated against the applicant or recipient shall not be required to qualify for emergency assistance to
- 6 cover rent arrears or public assistance to provide ongoing rental
- 7 support.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
