AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to requiring insurance coverage for pre-exposure prophylaxis and post-exposure prophylaxis to prevent HIV infection

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 36 to read as follows:
- (36) Every policy which provides coverage for prescription drugs shall include coverage for the cost of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) for the 5 prevention of HIV and post-exposure prophylaxis to prevent HIV 6 infection.
- 7 § 2. Subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 21 to read as follows: 8
- (21) Every policy which provides coverage for prescription drugs shall 10 include coverage for the cost of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) for the 11 prevention of HIV and post-exposure prophylaxis to prevent HIV 12 infection.
- 13 § 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (ss) to read as follows: 14
- (ss) Every contract issued by a hospital services corporation or a 15 16 health services corporation which provides coverage for prescription 17 drugs shall include coverage for the cost of pre-exposure prophylaxis (Prep) for the prevention of HIV and post-exposure prophylaxis to 18
- prevent HIV infection. 19

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20 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
