AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to adding possession of a flamethrower to the crime of criminal possession of a weapon in the fourth degree

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 265.00 of the penal law is amended by adding four new subdivisions 32, 33, 34 and 35 to read as follows:
- 3 32. "Flamethrower" means a device capable of projecting a stream of
 4 burning fuel a distance of at least three feet. Inoperable display units
 5 shall not be considered "flamethrowers" for the purposes of this
 6 section.
- 7 33. "Historical flamethrower" means a flamethrower constructed, in 8 whole or in substantial part, of components manufactured prior to nine-9 teen hundred sixty-six.
- 10 34. "Substantial part" means constructed with at least five signif-11 icant components manufactured prior to nineteen hundred sixty-six.
- 12 <u>35. "Significant components" means fully functional and necessary</u> 13 <u>parts for the operation of a flamethrower including:</u>
- 14 (a) fuel cell;
- 15 <u>(b) gas caps;</u>
- 16 (c) pressure regulator;
- 17 <u>(d) pressure bottle;</u>
- 18 <u>(e) hose;</u>
- 19 (f) wand fuel valve;
- 20 <u>(g) barrel;</u>
- 21 (h) front grip;
- 22 (i) ignition shield; and

§ 2. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 265.41 to read 3 as follows:

4 § 265.41 Criminal possession of a flamethrower.

A person is quilty of criminal possession of a flamethrower when he or 6 she possesses a flamethrower; provided, however, that nothing in this section shall prohibit the manufacture, remanufacture, restoration or alteration of flamethrower components. This section shall not apply to 9 <u>historical flamethrowers</u>, <u>flamethrowers</u> used for agricultural or 10 construction purposes or any flamethrower lawfully acquired and 11 possessed prior to the effective date of this section.

Criminal possession of a flamethrower is a class E felony. 12

§ 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 13 14 it shall have become a law.
