AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to including Lyme disease and other tick-borne diseases as occupational diseases for purposes of workers' compensation

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 30 of subdivision 2 of section 3 of the workers' compensation law, as renumbered by chapter 665 of the laws of 1971, is renumbered paragraph 31 and a new paragraph 30 is added to read as 4 follows:

30. Any process involving outdoor activity or treatment of animals.

- 8 § 2. The closing paragraph of subdivision 2 of section 3 of the work-9 ers' compensation law, as amended by chapter 666 of the laws of 1971, is 10 amended to read as follows:
- Nothing in paragraph [thirty] thirty-one of this subdivision shall be construed to apply to any disability or death due to any disease described in paragraph twenty-nine of this subdivision.
- 14 § 3. Subdivision 9 of section 201 of the workers' compensation law is 15 amended by adding a new paragraph C to read as follows:
- 16 <u>C. "Disability" also includes disability caused by or in connection</u> 17 <u>with Lyme disease and other tick-borne diseases.</u>
- § 4. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rules or regulations necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made on or before such effective date.
