AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to designated essential support persons for individuals with disabilities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 2828 of the
2 public health law, as amended by a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending
3 the public health law relating to prohibiting general hospitals from
4 disallowing individuals with disabilities from having an essential
5 support person accompany them for the duration of their hospitalization,
6 as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 1035-A and A. 4685-A, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 (b) An individual with a disability or the legal guardian for the
9 individual shall be allowed to designate a single primary essential
10 support person to assist with communicating medical needs and managing
11 everyday needs during hospitalization and such essential support person
12 shall be limited to such individual's parent, spouse or caretaker.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same
14 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the public health law
15 relating to prohibiting general hospitals from disallowing individuals
16 with disabilities from having an essential support person accompany them
17 for the duration of their hospitalization, as proposed in legislative
18 bills numbers S. 1035-A and A. 4685-A, takes effect.
