AN ACT to amend the cannabis law, in relation to establishing an adultuse cultivator provisional license

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The cannabis law is amended by adding a new section 68-c to 2 read as follows:

§ 68-c. Adult-use cultivator provisional license. 1. If the board has not established the process for the issuance of adult-use cultivator's licenses by January first, two thousand twenty-two, it shall provide any applicant an adult-use cultivator's provisional license pursuant to guidelines established by the board. Such provisional license shall provide the same authorizations granted to any adult-use cultivator pursuant to section sixty-eight of this article and shall take effect no later than March first, two thousand twenty-two. The board may establish a date by which such provisional licenses shall expire.

2. If the board has not established the process for either: (a) the issuance of an adult-use cultivator's license; or (b) the issuance of an adult-use cultivator's provisional license by January first, two thousand twenty-two, the department of agriculture and markets shall, within thirty days, establish and issue such provisional licenses until such time that the board is able to do so.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
