AN ACT in relation to directing the New York State Office for People With Developmental Disabilities to establish a voluntary training and certification program for employers that have taken the EmployAbility Pledge; and making an appropriation therefor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. a. The New York State Office for People With Developmental
2 Disabilities (OPWDD) shall establish a voluntary training and certif-
3 ication program for employers that have taken the EmployAbility Pledge
4 and that support an inclusive workplace. The program shall promote tech-
5 niques and strategies employers can implement to increase diversity in
6 the employer's workforce through the hiring of individuals with disabil-
7 ities and to increase diversity in the selection of the employer's
8 supply chains by working with companies that employ individuals with
9 disabilities.
- 10 b. OPWDD will develop and manage the program. As part of the program,
11 OPWDD will develop a series of online/virtual training programs for
12 employers for key components related to training employers on topics
13 including:
- 14 (i) sensitivity training on disability disclosure;
 - 15 (ii) providing reasonable accommodations to employees with disabili-
16 ties;
 - 17 (iii) tax credits for employers who employ individuals with disabil-
18 ities;
 - 19 (iv) website accessibility;
 - 20 (v) interviewing individuals with disabilities and appropriate job
21 opening advertisements;
 - 22 (vi) workplace inclusion of individuals with disabilities;
 - 23 (vii) supply chain diversity;

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1 (viii) the role of job coaches in assisting employers; and
2 (ix) corporate partnership training for employers for purposes of
3 qualifying for preferred source procurement status.
4 § 2. The sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is here-
5 by appropriated to the New York State Office for People With Develop-
6 mental Disabilities out of any moneys in the state treasury in the
7 general fund to the credit of the state purposes account, not otherwise
8 appropriated, and made immediately available, for the purpose of carry-
9 ing out the provisions of this act. Such moneys shall be payable on the
10 audit and warrant of the comptroller on vouchers certified or approved
11 by the head of the New York State Office for People With Developmental
12 Disabilities in the manner prescribed by law.
13 § 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
14 have become a law.
