AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of making a terroristic threat against a police officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 490.21 to 2 read as follows:
- § 490.21 Making a terroristic threat against a police officer. 3
- 1. A person is guilty of making a terroristic threat against a police 5 officer when with intent to intimidate or coerce a civilian population, 6 influence the policy of a unit of government by intimidation or coer-7 cion, or affect the conduct of a unit of government by murder, assassination or kidnapping, he or she threatens to commit or cause to be committed a specified offense against a police officer and thereby caus-9 es a reasonable expectation or fear of the imminent commission of such
- 10 11 offense against a police officer.
- 12 2. It shall be no defense to a prosecution pursuant to this section 13 that the defendant did not have the intent or capability of committing the specified offense or that the threat was not made to a person who 14 15 was a subject thereof.
- 16 Making a terroristic threat against a police officer is a class C 17 **felony.**
- § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-18 ing the date on which it shall have become a law. 19
