AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to  
educating the public about the health and environmental impacts of  
lithium-ion batteries for electric vehicles, and the manufacturing  
thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 2 of section 19-0301 of the  
2 environmental conservation law is amended to read as follows:

3 b. Encourage voluntary cooperation by all persons in controlling air,  
4 water and soil pollution and air, water and soil contamination, includ-  
5 ing, but not limited to, educating the public about the health and envi-  
6 ronmental impacts of lithium-ion battery use and manufacture, such as  
7 toxicity and contamination resultant from battery leakage or deteri-  
8 oration, environmental impacts of lithium-ion battery casualties and  
9 disposal and health risks associated with exposure to lithium-ion  
10 battery components. The department shall also consider the environ-  
11 mental, health and safety factors associated with extreme-heat lithium  
12 battery fires, and effects on the equipment, health and safety of first  
13 responders in the event of an extreme-heat battery casualty. Such educa-  
14 tion shall, at a minimum, include developing and distributing educa-  
15 tional materials and posting such information on the department's  
16 website.

17 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
