AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the county of Nassau as the "Police Officer Daniel J. Greer Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-n to read as follows:

3 § 344-n. Portion of the state highway system to be designated and 4 known as the "Police Officer Daniel J. Greer Memorial Bridge". The 5 bridges on Sunnyside Boulevard in the hamlet of Plainview, crossing the 6 Long Island Expressway near exit 46 in the county of Nassau shall each 7 be designated and known as the "Police Officer Daniel J. Greer Memorial 8 Bridge".

9 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-10 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 11 as designated pursuant to section one of this act; provided that, to 12 avoid any confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, 13 the designations called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be 14 one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridges shall not 15 be changed as a result of this act.

16 § 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
