AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the Mount Van Hoevenberg Olympic Sports Complex

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. Article 9 of the environmental conservation law is amended
2	by adding a new title 23 to read as follows:
3	TITLE 23
4	THE MOUNT VAN HOEVENBERG OLYMPIC SPORTS COMPLEX
5	Section 9-2301. Legislative purpose and intent.

11	<u>§ 9-2301. Legislative purpose and intent.</u>
12	1. It is the intent of the legislature to hereby implement the amend-
13	ment to section one of article fourteen, of the New York state constitu-
14	tion pertaining to the Mount Van Hoevenberg Olympic Sports Complex
15	located on forest preserve lands in the town of North Elba in Essex
16	County.
17	2. The legislature further intends that implementation of the consti-
18	tutional amendment should be accomplished in a manner that ensures the
19	integrity of the forest preserve land on which the sports complex is
20	situated and results in a significant increase of forest preserve acre-
21	age in the Adirondack park.
22	3. The legislature intends that, as offset for the use of forest
23	preserve lands for the sports complex, the state shall acquire as an
24	addition to the forest preserve at least two thousand five hundred acres
25	of true forest land located in the Adirondack park. To ensure that such
26	lands will be acquired and have characteristics suitable for inclusion
27	in to the forest preserve, the legislature intends to review and approve
28	the acquisition of such lands.
29	4. For these reasons and as authorized by the provisions of section
30	one of article fourteen of the state constitution, the legislature finds

1	that it is in the public interest to hereby implement the constitutional
2	amendment pertaining to the Mount Van Hoevenberg Olympic Sports Complex.
3	§ 9-2302. Definitions.
4	For purposes of this title, the following terms shall have the follow-
5	ing meanings:
б	1. "Appurtenances" shall mean those facilities that are directly
7	related to and necessary for the construction, operation, maintenance,
8	and public use of modern Nordic skiing and biathlon trails, such as
9	access roads, parking lots, sanitary facilities, offices, day lodges and
10	amenities, snowmaking, five kilometer of paved training trails, and an
11	open-air Nordic skiing and biathlon stadium. This term shall not
12	include:
13	(a) facilities such as zip lines, hotels, condominiums, swimming
14	pools, all-terrain vehicles or off-road vehicles for public use, tennis
15	courts and other structures and improvements which are not directly
16	related to and necessary for operation, maintenance, and public use of
17	the sports complex; or
18	(b) any structure located at or above an elevation of two thousand two
19	hundred feet above sea level used for the sale of any goods, services,
20	<u>merchandise, food, or beverage.</u>
21	2. "Mount Van Hoevenberg Olympic Sports Complex" means a one thousand
22	thirty-nine and two-tenths acre parcel of forest preserve land located
23	in the town of North Elba in Essex County on which the Mount Van Hoeven-
24	berg Olympic Sports Complex is currently located. For purposes of this
25	title, land owned by the town of North Elba which is located adjacent to
26	forest preserve land and over which the state has an easement, including
27	land on which the Olympic bobsled run is located, shall not be consid-
28	ered part of such sports complex.
29	§ 9-2303. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the Mount Van
30	Hoevenberg Olympic Sports Complex.
31	Not more than three hundred twenty-two and twenty-six hundredths acres
32	of forest preserve land at the Mount Van Hoevenberg Olympic Sports
33	Complex may be used for the construction, operation, and maintenance of
34	Nordic skiing and biathlon trails, and appurtenances thereto. Any and
35	all development at the sports complex shall conform to guidelines set
36	forth in the Adirondack park state land master plan and shall be author-
37	ized by a unit management plan, as required by section eight hundred
38	sixteen of the executive law.
39	§ 9-2304. Land to be acquired for inclusion in the forest preserve in
40	the Adirondack park.
41	As an offset for the use of forest preserve lands for the sports
42	complex, the state shall acquire no less than two thousand five hundred
43	acres of land for inclusion in the forest preserve in the Adirondack
44	park, subject to legislative approval. Such approval shall include a
45	metes and bounds description and an accurate survey of the lands proposed for inclusion in the forest preserve.

47 48	§ 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as a "CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY proposing
40 49	an amendment to section 1 of article 14 of the constitution, in relation
49 50	to the Mount Van Hoevenberg Olympic Sports Complex in Essex County"
50 51	takes effect, in accordance with section 1 of article 19 of the consti-
52	tution. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of
53	any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on
54	its effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before
55	such effective date.
