AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to eligibility for the appropriation of moneys for the promotion of agriculture and domestic arts

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 286 of the agriculture and markets law, as amended by chapter 600 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:

2 (a) To qualify for premium reimbursement under this section, agricultural and horticultural corporations, the county extension service association in the county of Orange, the American institute in the city of New York, the Goshen Historic Track, Inc. and the Genesee Valley Breeders' Association, Inc. must have held, with the approval of the commissioner, an annual fair or exposition for the promotion of agriculture and domestic arts during the previous calendar year, paid at least
3 [five] two thousand five hundred dollars in actual premiums and filed an
4 annual report as required in paragraph (c) of this subdivision.

5 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
