AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to prohibiting the denial of a building permit on the basis that such building will be a mixed-fuel building

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The general municipal law is amended by adding a new 2 section 99-y to read as follows:
- § 99-y. Prohibition on mixed-fuel buildings. 1. No municipal corpotration shall prohibit the issuing of a permit for the construction of any new commercial, residential, or mixed-use building on the basis that such building will be a mixed-fuel building.
- 7 2. As used in this section, the following terms shall have the follow-8 ing meanings:
- 9 <u>a. "Mixed-use building" shall mean a building used for both residen-</u>
 10 <u>tial and commercial purposes.</u>
- b. "Mixed-fuel building" shall mean a building that uses a combination of electricity and natural gas, propane, or oil to meet building energy needs.
- 14 <u>c. "Building energy needs" shall mean all space conditioning including</u>
 15 <u>heating and cooling, water heating including pools and spas, cooking</u>
 16 <u>appliances and clothes drying appliances.</u>
- 17 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
