WHEREAS, This remarkable gentleman also served as Chair of the Rochester/Monroe County Freedom Trail Commission and has actively been involved with the Rochester Kwanzaa Coalition and the 150 Ancestors Project for many years; and

WHEREAS, For his incredible legacy and long-term contributions to the public understanding and appreciation of African American history, culture, and heritage, Dr. David Anderson was the recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award from Black Men Achieve and was honored by the National Association for African American Studies and Affiliates (NAAAS) at Nazareth College, where he was a visiting scholar; and WHEREAS, Rare indeed is the impressive dedication shown by an individual for the benefit of others which Dr. David Anderson has displayed throughout his life; and
