WHEREAS, Senator John J. Bonacic was named Chairman of the Senate Judiciary Committee and was responsible for the oversight of the Governor's Judicial Nominations (2011); and

WHEREAS, John J. Bonacic resides in Mount Hope, New York, with his wife, Pat, and together they are the proud parents of two children and the loving grandparents of three grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Every citizen in New York State has most certainly benefited, in one way or another, from the deep dedication, intelligence and commitment former Senator John J. Bonacic brought to his work as a legislator, loyal friend, and trusted advisor; and
