WHEREAS, Thanks to the courageous actions of the Ferry's captain and crew, the little girl regained breathing, consciousness and color; today, she is home playing, talking and singing, having made a full recovery; and

WHEREAS, For their diligence, bravery and professionalism, these 12 noble men played a vital role in this extraordinary rescue effort, and should be praised by the people of this great Empire State for their astute actions in preserving the life of another; and

WHEREAS, In their spontaneous and heroic acts, the captain and crew of the Grand Republic Ferry have so aptly demonstrated their character and compassion for the welfare of others, personifying, by virtue of their actions, the collective concern of ordinary citizens across the community of New York State who voluntarily respond without thought of danger or reward when others are in need of help; now, therefore, be it
