WHEREAS, In keeping with The Links, Incorporated mandate to enhance the quality of life in their community through its volunteer community service programs, the Greater Queens Chapter has focused its energies and commitment to follow the four facet programming guidelines established by The Links Incorporated which are National Trends and Services, The Arts, Services to Youth and International Trends and Services; and
