WHEREAS, The Peace Flag will be displayed annually at the United Nations on September 21st, the International Day of Peace, and includes contributions from individuals from the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, Artistic activism fosters community and provides a mechanism for people to utilize their creativity and personal experiences to effect change and impact the world in a positive way; now, therefore, be it
